Background Information

NETFUND is spearheading the implementation of the “**Restoration and Sustainable Management of the Cherang’any Forest Ecosystem for Climate Change Resilience and Improved Livelihoods.**” Project, focusing on West Pokot and Elgeyo Marakwet Counties.

The project aims to:

- Rehabilitate degraded forest areas through community-led restoration efforts
- Promote sustainable livelihoods and nature-based enterprises for forest-adjacent communities
- Strengthen the capacity local conservation groups to undertake conservation initiatives and adapt to climate change impacts

NETFUND intends to work with **local Community Conservation Groups** across the Cherang’any Ecosystem. These groups are vital partners in implementing on-the-ground activities such as tree planting, seedling production, and environmental stewardship.

Call for Community Grant Applications

As part of this initiative, NETFUND is inviting **eligible community-based groups** to apply for **grants (in-kind or financial)** to strengthen their role in ecosystem restoration and livelihood enhancement activities.

This application window provides an opportunity for local groups to access resources and technical support to scale up their impact in environmental conservation, aligning with the project’s broader Objective of **Restoring and Sustainably Managing the Cherangany Forest Ecosystems for Climate Resilience and Improved Livelihoods.**

Who Can Apply? (Eligibility Criteria)

To be considered for support under this grant program, applicants must meet the following criteria:

1. Registered Group Status:

The applying entity must be formally registered as one of the following:

- Community-Based Organization (CBO)
 - Self-Help Group
 - Community Forest Associations (CFAs)
 - Women’s Group
 - Youth Group
 - Indigenous People Associations/groups
- Registration must be with a legally recognized government body.*

2. Geographical Scope:

The group must be located within the Cherang’any Forest Ecosystem, specifically in West Pokot; Lelan, Siyoi, Sekerr and Weiwei wards and or Elgeyo Marakwet; Moiben/Kuserwo, Lelan, Sambirir and Endo Wards

3. Proof of Registration:

Applicants must provide a valid **registration certificate/license** as part of their application.
